

## Middle & High School Supply List 2010-2011

- Pencils
- Pens (blue, black and red)
- Package of colored pencils
- Highlighters
- Package of Markers
- Erasers
- Typex /Whiteout
- Glue Stick

The following items must be purchased from the school store:

- 1 composition book for theorem/postulate dictionary

- Post-its – various sizes and colors
- One 3-ring binder
- Spiral notebooks to be used only for English (3 pieces)

For Physics (grade 11 & 12):

- 1 composition notebook
- 1 3-ring binder
- For Chemistry (grade 11 & 12):
- 1 composition notebook
- 1 3-ring binder

For Environmental Systems and Societies, Marine Biology or Grade 10 Science:

- 1 composition notebook
- Graph paper

For Dutch:

- 3 ring binder & lined filler paper
