Helping Haiti

As we all know, a 7.0 earthquake struck the country of Haiti, leveling buildings, cutting off communications and leaving the world wondering about the state of this poor country. The lack of communications is hindering the ability to determine the full extent of damage and destruction.

You may bring your donations to our main office (there is a special box marked for this purpose). You may also make deposits directly to different banks in Curaçao. Red Cross Curaçao disaster relief accounts are as follows (preferably mark the deposit "Akshon yuda Haiti"):

Money deposited into these accounts will be sent to the Red Cross HQ in Geneva (or to an account they designate) to help Haiti.
